AN IMPORTANT REMINDER!

The **second quarter meeting** will be held on **Tuesday, May 11, 2010**, at the Tanner Trails Community Church located at the end of Orr Court. (Please note that the meeting is on a Tuesday night this quarter, rather than a Wednesday, due to scheduling conflicts.) Elections will be held at this meeting. Nomination forms are still being accepted. Included in this mailing are nomination and proxy forms.

In order to hold the election, a minimum of **170 households need to be represented** either in person or by proxy. Should you be unable to attend the May meeting, please submit a proxy form. Additional nomination and proxy forms, along with information for submission can be found online at www.tannertrailshoa.org. Proxy and nomination forms may be submitted beginning now through the day of the election. UTILITY MARKINGS

You may have recently noticed marking on utilities throughout the subdivision. This is part of Phase I of the GIS Program that the Village of North Aurora is using. The markings are for locating all public utilities from storm sewers, fare end sections to the ponds, water shutoffs for the homes, water mains, and hydrants. The different colors are to identify the different utilities. All this information will be on a computer program which will help when talking with developers and also bring the Village up to speed on where everything is exactly located. As part of this program in the future the Village will add trees and street lights, as well.

COMMUNITY CLEAN UP

Garbage Cans

Please note that garbage cans and recycling bins are not allowed to be stored in the front of the home. Garbage cans and recycling bins may not be visible from the street per North Aurora Village ordinance.

The Fox Valley Park District was contacted this spring with a request to clean up the Tanner Trails Park from both debris and goose droppings. The FVPD sent out workers to sweep the paths to remove the droppings.

Regarding debris throughout the subdivision, Waste Management allows for the use of recycled items to be placed in garbage cans with lids that are marked with the word "recycling." Garbage

cans with lids may be purchased at stores such as Target and Home Depot for as little as \$10. The use of these garbage cans can cut down on the amount of debris that blows throughout the subdivision each week. In addition, large recycling cans with lids can be rented from Waste Management. You may contact Waste Management can be contacted at (800)-796-9696. Please consider using a garbage can with a lid instead of the open bins which Waste Management provides.

Also, the Village of North Aurora is hosting Spring Clean-Up Day on May 7, 2010. Regular garbage and yard waste require stickers as usual and all other items, large or small, will be removed for free (no stickers required). Discarded items must be in cans (not to exceed 32 gallons) or bags not exceeding 50 pounds. Bulk items such as tables or sofas are exempt from the weight restrictions on this clean up day. Household hazardous waste may be dropped off for free at the Naperville Fire Station at the corner of Rt. 59 and Brookdale Rd. between 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. on weekends, call 630-208-3841 for a list of acceptable items.
